Equine Dietary Supplement

Ingredients: Proprietary blend including *Coptis chinensis*, *Isatis indigotica*, *Lonicera japonica*, *Rhodiola rosea*, *Schisandra*, *Silybum marianum* (Milk Thistle), *Trifolium Pratense* (red clover) *Astragalus membranaceus*, *Angelica sinensis*, *Ginkgo biloba*, L Lysine, L-Arginine. *Punica granatum*, *Pulsatilla chinensis*, *Pueraria lobata*, *Licorice Glycyrrhiza*, *Polygonatum multiflorum*. *Eleutherococcus senticosus*, *Ligusticum sinense*

A Three-month protocol consisting of three different stages:

Each stage is administered individually until each and all are complete

Stage One

Ingredients:

Punica granatum. *Pulsatilla chinensis*, *Coptis chinensis*,

Total 362 grams

Dosage 1 x 10ml scoop morning and evening

Stage Two

Ingredients:

Silybum marianum (Milk Thistle), *Trifolium Pratense* (red clover), *Angelica sinensis*, *Pueraria lobata* L Lysine, L-Arginine. *Isatis indigotica*, *Lonicera japonica*, *Phellodendron Chinese*. *Licorice Glycyrrhiza*. *Polygonatum multiflorum*. *Ligusticum sinense*

Total 2,307 grams

Dosage 3 x 15ml scoop morning and 4 x 15ml scoop evening

Stage Three-

Ingredients:

Rhodiola rosea, *Schisandra*, *Ginkgo biloba*, *Astragalus membranaceus*, *Eleutherococcus senticosus*

Total 545grams

Dosage 1 x 10ml scoop morning and evening

Storage : Store in a dry room at temperatures between 4 and 30 degrees Celsius. Tightly re-seal tubs once opened.

Total Package Weight 3.2kg

Protocol Additions and Recommendations:

No horse undergoing the treatment protocol can be under strenuous exercise until at least stage 2 is complete and preferably time of during the whole protocol.

Strict attention must be paid to the diet during the treatment protocol and indefinitely.

We recommend using a high quality nutritional balancer throughout the feeding of the protocol and advisable to continue using indefinitely. This balancer should include all the essential minerals, vitamins and amino acids required for health and vitality.

Daily added Salt (Sodium chloride) x One Tablespoon day, please increase during summer months.

I also highly recommend that you change your feeding programme.

USA clients to use either Cool stance or Speedy Beet, non-GMO clean oats, Micronized Flaxseed.

Australian Clients: Please contact Carol Layton <https://www.balancedequine.com.au> for all advice on balanced nutrition. It is important that you use a substantial B Complex vitamin during treatment and ensure all magnesium, copper and zinc is balanced to dietary requirements.

Problems with dosing or side effects during protocol:

If any horse does not like the taste of the herbs then it is advised to mix with water and dose orally with syringe until horse acquires a taste for them, in these cases the horses in question are suffering with either gastric or colonic ulcers.

Side effects or herxheimer reactions have occurred in some horses, lethargy, rashes or pussy legions, Lameness due to foot Abscessing.

Some have sarcoids that eventually fall off, or generally off form. This is not a problem and no need to worry as it will pass.

Do not use during pregnancy

Please ensure that you continue with a healthy, non-GMO, balanced nutritional diet both throughout the protocol and ongoing afterwards.
